

# Inmate Tracking

## Location & Headcount Management



*DataWorks Plus' Inmate Tracking tracks inmate movements, events such as meal or headcount, as well as the distribution and collection of items such as razors, phone books, etc.*

### System Integration

The system integrates seamlessly with DataWorks Plus' Digital PhotoManager and NIST Manager. It can also be interfaced to your existing Jail Management System so that inmate data (Assigned Location, Keep Separates, etc.) are automatically downloaded in real time.

### Special Alerts

You may define special alerts: When the inmate is scanned, the officer will be provided valuable information ("diabetic", "special diet", "aggressive toward staff", etc.)

### Statistics & Customized Reports

Inmate movement and population statistics as well as customized reports can also be viewed and printed, which is helpful when requesting funding that is dependent upon accurate headcounts.

### Track by Fingerprint, Barcode, RFID

At booking, you may capture fingerprints and/or mugshots, which can be added to the inmate's record and use fingerprint matching or facial recognition to verify identity. You may also track inmates with customizable wristbands with barcodes or RFID. Your existing wristband system may be utilized to track and monitor the location of inmates. When integrated with the DataWorks Plus' Digital PhotoManager mugshot system, you will have the option to automatically print the wristband at booking.

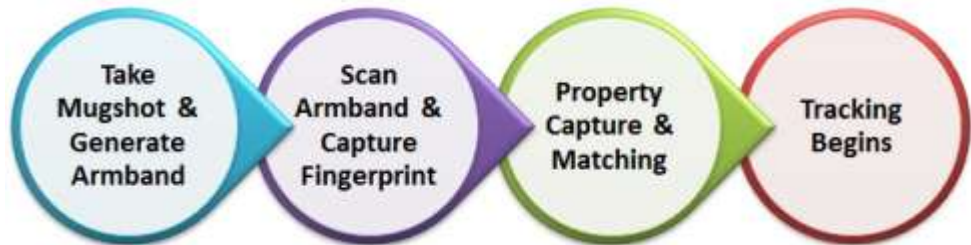

# Sample Workflow

DataWorks Plus has created numerous customized Inmate Tracking Systems for agencies across the country including systems in the Essex County (NJ) Sheriff's Office/Jail, Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office and Broward County. Below is a typical workflow of the DataWorks Plus inmate tracking system integrated with an existing jail management system.



## Take Mugshot & Generate Armband

The arrestee's information is entered into the Jail Management System (JMS) and a mugshot is taken. In some cases, the mugshot is taken at the livescan station and data is pushed or pulled to the JMS or dynamically accessed to create the armband. The Arrestee is then given an armband with a barcode representing the booking number generated by the JMS system.



## Scan Armband & Capture Fingerprint

The JMS system sends an electronic copy of the booking data record to the DataWorks Plus Inmate Tracking system to eliminate duplicate data entry. The arrestee's armband is scanned with a barcode scanner for tracking and identification purposes before capturing his fingerprint electronically with a single finger reader for the optional RAPID-ID system. The arrestee's armband and fingerprint are scanned and matched for tracking and identification purposes and the corresponding arrest record is automatically retrieved.



## Property Capture & Matching

The arrestee then is moved to the property capture station where the arrestee's armband and fingerprint are scanned and matched for tracking and identification purposes. The corresponding arrest record is automatically retrieved. The booking officer captures an arrestee property photo that is attached to the arrest record. The arrestee signs an electronic signature pad that states he agrees that his property is complete.

## Tracking Begins

With the bar-coded armband and the DataWorks Plus Inmate Tracking application, jail employees track arrestee movements. Fingerprint matching or facial recognition can be used to verify identity. At inmate release, the armband and fingerprint are scanned and matched for tracking and identification purposes.
